



# THE NAME SAYS IT ALL

*A Legendary jacket for women!*

OKAY, LADIES, HOW MANY OF YOU ARE tired of wearing your significant other's leather? I know I am, but what's a girl to do when the cycle-clothing market is dominated by menswear? Until recently, I didn't have a good answer or alternative. But once I came across Legendary USA's For Ladies Only jackets, I was in hog heaven. Legendary offers three terrific-looking styles specifically designed to fit a woman's figure. I chose the Sturgis model (\$329.95), and, without question, it's the best leather jacket I've ever owned. There's lots of features worth mentioning, so let me cover a few.

First, the Sturgis is made from top-quality naked cowhide; it has a great broken-in feel straight off the hanger, but it has enough heaviness to set it apart from lesser jackets. There's also a zip-out lining, which allows me to look and feel cool, or add an inner layer if necessary. Second, all the zippers and snaps are blacked out, giving the jacket a stylish,

understated look, which is something I really like. The Sturgis doesn't have a belt (as does the Legendary Classic ladies jacket), but the tapered cut and adjustable side lacing allow for a snug fit. I stand 5'8" and the medium was perfect. What I love most about this jacket is that it has a feminine look to it without being too girly. I'm not into pastel colors or fringe, and the Sturgis is exactly like one of my husband's vintage bike jackets, except that it fits me correctly.

I'm sure that AIM's Women's POV Editor Genevieve Schmitt will agree when I say that I don't like looking boxy in a leather jacket, which is what happens when I'm wearing something cut for a man. But with the Legendary Sturgis ladies jacket, I won't have to worry about that happening again. **AIM**
